Holy Sacrament of Baptism A date and time for your child's Baptism can be provisionally given once you have completed the parish form and established a relationship with the parish. The choice of godparents is important. According to Canon Law, godparents must be at least 16 years of age,

practising Catholics and should have received the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation. The best instruction that you can give your child is through commitment to the Mass. As you make this request for your child, it should also be a reality in your own life for example: Do you regularly attend Mass? If after reading this information you feel ready to present, your child to the Church for Baptism please see Fr Larkin after Mass for Pre-Baptism form.

November Dead list envelopes are at the back of church for your November remembrance. Print the intentions and place in envelope with stipend. Return it before **1 November**. During the month of November special prayers for the Holy Souls and all on the November Dead List will be offered at Mass and during the following period Nov 2018 – Nov 2019.

A partial indulgence, applicable only to the souls in Purgatory, is granted to any of the faithful who 1) visit devoutly a cemetery or who simply pray mentally for the dead; 2) recite Morning or Evening Prayer of the Office of the Dead, or the invocation, Eternal rest grant... (Enchiridion of Indulgences, 1999, conc. 29).

Commemorative Bell-Ringing to Mark the Centenary of the End of the First World War Mr Edmund Anderson DL KSG, Her Majesty's Lord-Lieutenant of West Yorkshire, has asked that the churches of our diocese could take part in an initiative which forms part of the national commemorations marking the centenary of the end of the First World War, our church will be joining the nation as we ring out the peace on our church bells.

"Her Majesty's Government's ambition is for bells to ring out at 12.30pm on 11th November to commemorate the centenary of the Armistice which signalled the end of the First World War. This will be a symbolic way to give thanks for the end of war 100 years ago and will replicate the national outpouring of relief that took place at the end of the war as news of the Armistice filtered through and bells which had long been silent rang out. Bells ringing out at 12.30 will help mark the shift in emphasis from Remembrance in the morning to thanksgiving in the afternoon for the end of war and for peace.
