We have a duty of care for all Children and Vulnerable Adults within our Parish, and must comply with the Diocesan Safeguarding procedures. Secondly, I would like to thank Irene Hellowell for her support. The DBS certificates are renewed every 3 years. I am reviewing the DBS certificate register for the parish. Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) Fr Larkin uses the online Update Service.

This is annually checked. Fr Larkin's DBS certificate is dated 21/09/2018 Enhanced and will be submitted again in September 2019.

Holy Sacrament of Baptism A date and time for your child's Baptism can be provisionally given once you have completed the parish form and established a relationship with the parish. The choice of godparents is important. According to Canon Law, godparents must be at least 16 years of age, practising Catholics and should have received Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation. Parents are responsible for instructing and forming their children in both the teaching and practice of the Catholic faith. The best instruction that you can give your child is through commitment to the Mass. As you make this request for your child, it should also be a reality in your own life.
